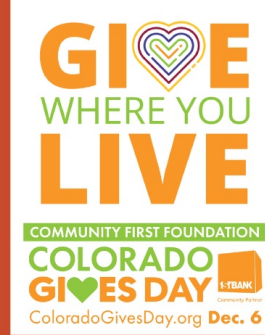


Message from the Board President

The Colorado Theatre Guild is continuing to work on behalf of the theatre community statewide. We are ecstatic to bring the first ever statewide combined auditions—the Unified Auditions, in April 2023! Actors can audition for producers from around the state at one location, and producers can observe actors from all around the state. Producers can sign up now via our [Unified Auditions portal](#), and actors can start their sign up in 2023.

We are also excited to introduce a tool to help individual members share their talents/skill sets with the community: the CTG Directory. This database will provide a space to showcase your talent by uploading your resume, video reel, and photos of your work. If anyone is seeking a designer, a puppeteer, a grant writer, a performer, and more...the Directory will help to make those connections. We hoped to have it ready by November, but we are taking necessary time to enhance the tech to work more smoothly. It will be here by the first of the year.
